- Front-End testing extended to Jan. 3, 2012

Data Specification Approach

- Perform a complete data analysis (DB, Systems)
- Document data detail comparison
- Reviewed potential CMS model changes
ICD-9 - ICD-10, RAPS Parallel processing, MMR, MOR, PACE/ESRD HCC Model Changes
- Begin revising ETL process
- Modify business rules engine
- Encounter Data translator and processing engine

October

- Finalize Cognisight 5010 file format requirements and send to clients
- Request 5010 test data in preferred format
- Schedule and perform technical reviews
- Begin making changes to business rules engine
- Begin testing EDI translator and ETL processing engine
- Begin testing EDS Front-End engine
